What sets the AIM program apart from Festival is that it also focuses on music theory skills (through a written test) in addition to performance, and as such requires an even higher level of commitment in time, hard work and dedication.

This year, Ms. Ward is working with some of her students to help them prepare for testing (in March of 2011). Participation in AIM is <u>optional</u>, and it is <u>not</u> too late to get involved. Interested students (who are prepared to work hard) should speak with Ms. Ward for details.

Fees for AIM workbooks (payable to Alyce Ward) are as follows: <u>Levels 1a, 1b, 1c</u> - \$5.00 <u>Levels 2 and above</u> - \$7.00
