(TESSI) in Carbondale was established as an L.L.C. in 2005 and founded by business partners Joyce Nelson, violinist and Alyce Ward, pianist along with associate David Stoecker, guitar.

As an independent school of music, TESSI is financed by tuition fees assessed for each 40-week school year. Tuition fees range from \$881.00 to 1684.00, and can be paid in one lump sum or in twelve installments. Pre-school Wiggles N' Tunes® classes are given in eight and sixteen-week sessions with fees of \$80.00 and \$160.00 per session.

The majority of TESSI students reside in the Carbon-dale/Murphysboro area and east along the Highway 13 corridor communities of Carterville, Herrin and Marion. A number of students commute from adjacent counties, Eldorado and Mount Vernon.

TESSI's mission is to provide and enriched music education choice for very young children to adults in a positive, can-do environment in which the needs and well-being of students comes first.

Talent Education, which is commonly known as the Suzuki Method includes these features:
